

Overview

Endomedix has created a new chemistry platform for a suite of biosurgical devices. The first spinoff is PlexiClot™ Absorbable Hemostat for brain & spinal surgery. PlexiClot provides a breakthrough with new patented mechanisms of action that solve important problems in this high value market and is the first fundamental innovation in this space since 1945. PlexiClot will improve clinical outcomes by reducing complications (e.g., revision procedures, infections) & morbidity. It will shorten procedure time, reducing OR & post op costs, and help reduce readmission. PlexiClot will be the first device specifically approved by FDA for this indication and is protected by 10 issued patents.

Significant Problems in High Value Surgeries

Standard ligature & techniques for hemostasis are not possible due to sensitive tissues. Tissues are surrounded by boney confines, Surgeons use electrocautery whenever possible, but use absorbable hemostats otherwise. Current devices swell (20%-200%), potentially compressing nerve tissue & airways, requiring reoperation. Current Devices are slow acting, prolonging cases & leading to higher avoidable cost and complication. These devices are opaque & obscure surgeons' vision and require manual compression & drugs for efficacy.

Market Opportunity

The obtainable serviceable market is 5.4 million relevant brain and spine surgeries in US & OUS geographical markets of interest, producing \$1.8 B market opportunity. These devices are often used several times in a single procedure.

PlexiClot™ Absorbable Hemostat

PlexiClot is a hand-held instrument that delivers a spray of polysaccharide solutions to the bleeding site. Within seconds, the spray forms a structured and dynamic multifunctional hemostat *in situ*. PlexiClot stops blood flow within seconds, forms a stable clot without compression or drugs, gently shrinks in use, and is transparent. Device breaks down into sugars and is resorbed.

Management Team

CEO is a 35+ year Medtech vet with success in new products & two prior start-ups with successful exits. Strong regulatory, clinical & international experience. After neuro launch, PlexiClot will enter other surgical subspecialties. Platform will generate additional biosurgical device product groups. The Company has a program with US Army Medical Materiel Development Command for a device for ocular projectile battlefield trauma.

M&A exits for PMA devices typically occur prior to final FDA approval. Company anticipates exit end of Year 3. Next investment round with a substantial step up in valuation.








Current 3D x-ray imaging technology leaves a lot of people with no access to the best standard of care, important applications undeveloped and a lot of money on the table. Sizeable populations in the U.S. and larger populations overseas suffer the table. Sizeable populations in the U.S. and larger populations overseas suffer

unnecessarily high rates of premature death, massive healthcare costs and a host of other problems without suitable x-ray screening and diagnostic capabilities. Stellarray will help change that with groundbreaking portable tomographic imaging systems that can be used virtually anywhere, including the point of care. Our focus now is on a portable digital breast tomosynthesis (DBT) system. "3D mammograms" have transformed mammography over the past decade by substantially reducing false negative and positive readings, with consequent health and economic benefits. They are quickly taking over this \$2 Bn market growing at over 14% a year, but this leaves a lot of people out. Many women in rural, inner city, tribal areas and in the veteran's care system have limited or no access to DBT – and these women have the highest rates of late-stage breast cancer diagnosis and morbidity. To the extent they are served at all it is through mobile clinic outreach programs ("big pink buses") that have sparse coverage and very high costs.

Stellarray's solution is a truly portable DBT system (PBTS) that will have all the benefits of conventional DBT systems, but weigh 3% as much, occupy 5% the space and cost 60% less, at \$125K. PBTS will transform the outreach market from big pink buses to little pink suitcases holding a kit with our unique x-ray source, off-the-shelf detector, power supply, simple paddle and support hardware that can be set up in schools, churches, community centers, retail clinics and even homes. The key innovation is our multi-spot, digitally addressable x-ray source using proprietary cold cathodes in an extremely rugged vacuum package with integrated electronics and



power supply. PBTS will actually improve image quality by eliminating the motion artifacts caused the usual tube rotation. The next version will turn the system on its side so the breast can be scanned with no compression as the woman lies on a cot or bed. PBTS will take either 13 or 25 exposures that will be processed using commercial reconstruction algorithms on a high-end laptop equipped with telemedicine and AI links.

Stellarray's team has already made a similar digitally addressable x-ray source for NASA to use on extended space missions for imaging a range of medical conditions. To this core team of Mark Eaton and Dr. Ron Hellmer, we will be adding the former director of x-ray source development for a European CT company and the former CTO of a





mobile CT company. UT Dell Medical Schools Faculty members - Dr. Jack Virostko who runs breast cancer screening trials and his colleagues running the mammography outreach programs - will support development.

Our "stationary tomography" pipeline has many branches. Our next product will be a portable tomography system for emergency medicine and military applications to bring high-quality x-ray imaging to the point of care during the "golden hour." A high-speed pre-clinical CT system is also in the works. Improved versions will add monochromatic and phase contrast imaging capabilities. We will sell our sources to other system developers, especially at medical schools, for them to develop reconstruction and AI algorithms that we can later bundle. We will license the technology for what we expect will be a numerous other imaging applications. Several companies (Nanox, VEC, Adaptix, Xintek) are getting into these areas, but none have portable systems.

We seek an A round of \$6 Mn for team building, early marketing, additional equipment, further IP development beyond our current 7 issued patents and prototype builds. This gets us to a PBTS prototype tested with imaging phantoms in two years. We expect PBTS will qualify for 510(k) clearance and that sales can begin within another year. We'll start with the outreach market, move into general mammography and then expand globally, especially in developing countries. Stellarray has won over \$12 Mn in competitive non-dilutive funding, mainly for "irradiators" to replace Cs-137. One such system is being tested now and some of the technology is being licensed. Part of the A round may be supplied by co-funding from other non-dilutive sources. We expect \$67 Mn in revenue in five years, mainly from imaging system sales, source sales and licensing.


