Tien is CEO of Opus8, an investment and advisory firm which helps technology companies and alternative investment fund managers raise capital. He is also Chairman of Lumious, a leader in corporate tech training and learning analytics, as well as Chairman of Lore Systems, a provider of network engineering, cloud computing, and strategic IT consulting.

In 1991, Tien co-founded and served as CEO of CyberRep, Inc. until its acquisition in 2003 by Affiliated Computer Services. CyberRep was one of the largest CRM outsourcing companies in the world with over 2,300 employees and \$80 million in revenue. Acute membrane repair for deadly degenerative diseases

Problem: Protein misfolding diseases

- Over 50 deadly degenerative diseases associated with protein misfolding and aggregation: Alzheimer's (AD), Parkinson's (PD), Huntington's (HD), ALS, type II diabetes, many rare diseases.
- Enormous burden: 540M patients, require 10 years of full-time care, 3.6 million deaths per year, USD 3 trillion associated costs, USD 95B drug market, rapid growth with aging population.
- High unmet need: Many symptomatic treatments available, but still no safe and effective disease-modifying treatments that can stop or reverse disease progression.
- Common mechanism: Toxic soluble misfolded protein oligomers form amyloid pores that puncture holes in cell membranes, just like bacterial pore-forming toxins, causing uncontrolled calcium influx, loss of homeostasis and cellular function, oxidative stress, inflammation, progressive cell death and degeneration.

Solution: Amporin's technology & USP

- Amporin Pharmaceuticals AG is developing the first breakthrough new class of oral small molecule drugs that can block, dissolve and degrade amyloid pores within cellular membranes.
- Novel and unique mode of action: Can uniquely protect and repair cell membranes from the damage caused by toxic soluble protein oligomers, allowing cells to fully recover and restore homeostasis.
- USP: First potential acute oral disease-modifying drugs to stop and reverse progression of more than 50 deadly degenerative diseases associated with protein misfolding and aggregation.
- Proof of concept: Demonstrated complete reversal of neurological deficits with single oral dose in AD and PD mouse models.
- Vision: Cure 6 major degenerative diseases with a simple pill.

Business & development plan

- R&D pipeline: Developing 6 drug candidates to deliver 1 new drug per year, starting with Parkinson's disease and ALS.
- Out-license to Big Pharma after rapid biomarker-based proof of mechanism and efficacy with acute oral dosing in Phase 1b/2a trials. No need for big, long, costly trials to demonstrate delay in disease progression.

- 3 cofounders: Dr Kelvin Stott (CEO), Dr Hervé Schaffhauser (CSO), Prof Daniel Umbricht MD (CMO).


Funding & investment opportunity

- CHF 350K raised to date: Founders (CHF 100K equity); Venture Kick (CHF 150K loan); Kickfund (CHF 100K loan).
- Raising CHF 10-12M seed funding in 2025 to establish operations, strengthen data and IP, complete lead optimization in PD and ALS, and complete full preclinical development to file IND in PD.
- Plan to raise CHF 180-220M in 3-4 rounds of equity financing to reach first licensing deal by 2030/31.
- Exit by trade sale to Pharma: 40-50X exit multiple by 2030/31.




Amyloid pores cause cell death and degeneration




Amporin's unique approach: Targeting amyloid pores



Proof of Concept: Acute oral disease reversal in vivo






αSyn A53T transgenic mice, aged 9 months

Business model, development and financing plan

ANAKA PHARMACEUTICALS, INC

Value Proposition

Anaka Pharma aims to transform the lives of people with ADHD with a novel, best-in-class non-stimulant that is de-risked on efficacy and safety and with a highly cost-effective and focused development. Anaka's AKA1315 has a novel mechanism for ADHD representing the first significant innovation in the ADHD field since 2001.

Company Background: Anaka Pharma develops AKA1315, a fixed dose combination, repurposed small molecule drug candidate with a novel mechanism for impaired executive functioning in ADHD, Autism and Down syndrome. Anaka Pharma has Proof of Concept data in two studies in children with ADHD and the safety of the two underlying drugs is known and favorable with 800M doses dispenses every year.

Leadership Team: Mr. Hillerstrom (MSc MIT/HMS, MBA HBS) is the President and has 20+ years of experience in the biotech industry in different roles and has co-founded two companies previously. Dr. Luc-Andre Granier (MD, PhD) is a neurologist, psychiatrist and serial entrepreneur who started four companies, worked for 10 years at Eli Lilly Neuroscience, and brought five drugs to market. Mario Sanchez (Clinical Psychologist) sees patients in the clinic daily for 30+ years and is the inventor of the novel drug approach.

Products/Services: The ADHD stimulant drugs have strong efficacy to manage attention and hyperactivity symptoms but have significant side effects. Non-stimulant drugs have weaker efficacy but less significant side effects. There is an opportunity for a new non-stimulant drug with greater efficacy than current non-stimulant drugs and with a differentiated side effect profile. The drug candidate AKA1315 is highly differentiated (new drug class for ADHD), has human Proof of Concept data showing stronger efficacy than other non-stimulants, a favorable and differentiated safety profile and a well-defined regulatory pathway allowing increased speed and lower cost of development.

Technologies/Special Know-How: Anaka holds method of use patent applications in prosecution and had a favorable EU office action (expecting issues patent in early 2026). We are working with IP law firm Boult and our IP consultant to file additional patents including on the final formulation.

Market: ADHD affects 11% of children and 7% of adults in the US. The ADHD 2032E total addressable market is \$24.6BN (5.1% CAGR), out of which \$7.4BN is the non-stimulant market. Our market potential is \$1.8BN+ representing 15% of non-stimulant market plus 4% of stimulant market. We target a pharma acquisition at the end of Phase 2 in 2028. Biotech Neurovance developed the latest non-stimulant centanafadine and sold it to Otsuka after Phase 2 data for a total 13x investment return.

Distribution Channels: Late-stage Phase 3 clinical trials and the subsequent commercialization of AKA1315 will be conducted by the pharma partner. Given the drug's blockbuster potential, we expect multiple interested partners after Phase 2 data in ADHD.

Competition: All stimulants and three out of four non-stimulants are off patent. We expect two non-stimulants to still be protected at the time of AKA1315 market launch in 2031. In the stimulant class, we do not expect innovation on safety given the inherent side effects of the drug class. In the non-stimulant class, AKA1315 with its novel mechanism represents the first innovation since 2001 when repurposed anti-depressants showed promise in ADHD.

Technology

NanoSTING activates the innate immune system in the respiratory tract which is the first line defense for infections. It is designed to be administered before exposure to pathogens and prevent infection. When given after an infection it is intended to reduce the chances of developing serious illness.

Pipeline

NanoSTING-001: A standalone host-directed-therapeutic (HDT) being advanced for treatment or prevention of respiratory infections. HDTs are medicines that activate the individual's own mechanisms to fight disease, rather than directly targeting the pathogen, thus activating the body's initial defense against infection and improving clinical outcomes.

NanoSTING-002: A mucosal adjuvant for intranasal vaccines. A vaccine adjuvant is a substance added to enhance the immune response making it effective and potentially requiring a smaller dose. While many of today's approved vaccines administered via needle injection are formulated with adjuvants, NanoSTING-002 would be the first to help make needle-free intranasal vaccines more effective and widely available.

NanoSTING-003: A next generation HDT being developed by AuraVax.

Fetoscopy saves life but is risky

Each year, 800,000 fetuses face life-threatening malformations. Fetoscopies can treat these issues in utero but carry a 80% risk of preterm birth due to amniotic sac puncture. This complication causes significant neonatal care costs and long-term disabilities, making sac rupture a critical issue in fetoscopy.

Amniosnare[™] is the only solution

KOVE's Amniosnare, developed after 15 years of research at the University of Zurich, addresses this gap. The single-use device allows surgeons to anchor the amniotic sac to the uterus via a minimally invasive approach using the same fetoscopy catheter. This

reduces prematurity risks and enables the expansion of safe surgical procedures, saving lives and healthcare costs.

Annually, 8,000 fetoscopies are performed in 140 fetal treatment centers. By offering a safer procedure, we can treat fetuses earlier and increase recovery chances. By 2030, we estimate 27,000 fetuses could be treated, with KOVE used in 20,000 surgeries, generating CHF 100 million annually from fetoscopy alone. The technology will expand to fields like General Surgery and Robotics to address small port closure needs. Additional fetoscopy devices will be developed to meet urgent needs, with potential total revenue reaching CHF 200 million per year.

In 1895, Guglielmo Marconi used radio waves to transmit wireless signals **through open space**. This began the age of radio and wireless communications.






