Auctus Surgical is commercializing a novel dynamic vertebral body tethering system to treat pediatric scoliosis with an adjustable non-fusion approach. The Auctus system is designed from the ground up to address this important minimally-invasive treatment option for adolescents who otherwise would be facing complex fusion surgery. The system allows both freedom of movement and growth of the child's spine after surgery. Most importantly, the surgeon can adjust the tension on the implanted device non-invasively in their office at any time so that it can grow with the child.

This novel therapy has been developed by an accomplished team of business professionals with several successful exits (\$1.75B in total investor returns) and extensive experience with start-up medical device development in this market sector including previously commercializing an expandable interbody fusion cage which was acquired by Stryker after 2 rounds of funding at 16X multiple. Patents with broad claims covering the adjustable tether method and devices have been issued around the world, and a comprehensive international portfolio of related additional claims are being prosecuted.

The beachhead market for Auctus's system is skeletally immature patients that require surgical treatment to obtain and maintain correction of progressive idiopathic scoliosis, with a major Cobb angle of 30 to 65 degrees. This represents a \$750M market in the US alone. This innovative technology has broad utility applicable beyond this beachhead into which Auctus will expand after initial product success. The overall global market opportunity for the company is over \$6B/yr for just the pediatric indications (+ an additional \$10B for adult indications).

We are currently raising \$3M to complete bench and pre-clinical testing, obtain an IDE approval from the FDA to start clinical trials, and fund the company through the end of 2026.

VALUE PROPOSITION:

Restoring Vision, Not Just Managing Disease: 50% of patients improve vision by 10+ letters within 90-days.

Huge Market Opportunity: 200.0 Million are afflicted with Dry-AMD and projected market value of \$68.5 Billion by 2029.

Derisked Investment Opportunity: Backed by US feasibility study and well-positioned for FDA clearance in 2028

Ophthalmology Exit Potential: Comparable transactions (Alcon acquiring LumiThera for \$850.0M) would yield >12x return in mid-2028 for investors.

Company Background: Ophthalmology company with device-based therapy to improve vision in 200.0M people with Dry Age-related Macular Degeneration.

Leadership Team: Senior Management team has led FDA clearance for 16 Class II and III technologies and held leadership roles in 5 companies that have been acquired and delivered \$850.0 million in shareholder value.

Scientific/Medical Consultants: Dr. Sophie Bakri, Chair of Ophthalmology at the Mayo Clinic, Prof. Tim Cackson, Head of Retinal Research at King's College UK, and Dr. Jason Slackter, Vitreous Retina Macula Consultants of New York, and Robert Warner (Former President of the Americas, Alcon).

Products/Services: Retina Bio-Stimulation is low level electrical pulses delivered through an electrode placed on the eyelid to improve cellular structure and function of key Retinal cells to improve vision and slow disease progression.

Technologies/Special Know-How: i-Lumen's proprietary dual waveform algorithm generates unprecedented vision improvement – Studies demonstrates that 50% of patients improve vision by 10+ letters within 90-days of initial treatment.

Market: The US market opportunity is valued at US\$86.5 Billion by 2029. AMD is the leading cause of blindness in those over age 60 and it affects 1 in 4 people. Globally, more than 200.0 million have AMD.

Distribution Channels: i-Lumen's highly scalable business model represents an incremental revenue stream for Ophthalmology offices. Medicare reimbursement for daily treatments is projected to be between \$1,000 to \$1,400. Coupled with clinical results, physician reimbursement will drive adoption and utilization.

i-Lumen will leverage a Lasic vision correction surgery revenue model – 'pay per click model'. The device system is capital equipment and has a gross margin of 90%.

Competition: The treatment solutions available today, including Syfovre (Apellis) and Izervay (Astellas), which only slow the progress of the disease while vision loss continues. LumiThera delivers light therapy to the eye but their therapeutic only stabilizes vision – it's inferior to i-Lumen's therapy which improves vision.

Exit Strategy: Alcon acquired LumiThera (pre-revenue) for \$850.0 Million. A similar transaction for i-Lumen would yield a 12-15x investor return. i-Lumen has initiated conversations with leading strategics (Glaukos, Johnson&Johnson, Carl Zeiss, and Bausch+Lomb) and there is a significant level of interest in acquiring i-Lumen's technology following the availability of Pivotal Study data (early to mid-2028).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

An estimated 18 million people die annually from conditions that safe surgery could address. Safe, timely surgical intervention is the deciding factor between recovery, mortality, or long-term disability. Lack of safe surgery generates a Gross Domestic Product loss of \$12.3 trillion from lost annual productivity.

SurgiBox addresses a \$39B USD market by directly offering a solution to the above problem by dramatically reducing the upfront cost and geographic barriers to surgery while offering excellent safety standards. Our patented technology is an ultraportable sterile environment that improves the safety of surgeries any time, any place, by:

- a) reducing exposure of surgeons to patient bodily fluids
- b) protecting patients from the surrounding environment

In austere conditions, it makes safe surgeries possible where there are no existing facilities. Within hospitals, our solution increases operational throughput and decreases cost. Currently, surgical care relies upon consistent availability of three resources: 1) functional equipment and materials 2) appropriate facility space and 3) medical staff. Given the challenges of disseminating these resources consistently, surgical care is extremely limited in many austere settings. Even when in higher-resource settings, high costs and low throughput can present barriers to accessing safe surgery. Operating room facilities can cost up to \$60 USD per minute, and capacity limits of operating rooms can mean that surgeries take up to 365 days to schedule. Many countries globally are focused on solutions for reducing patient waiting times.

High equipment and facility costs are driven in part by maintaining the sterility of the entire operating room throughout the surgical procedure, regardless of the number of personnel and activity. This requires every surgical team member to wear extensive personal protective equipment, while sophisticated ventilation systems continuously run filtered air. When sterile environments are available in austere settings, semi-portable laminar airflow systems or operating suites mounted in vehicles and temporary buildings are the status quo. By contrast, the critical surgical site - the area of the body that is open and vulnerable to contamination - is never more than a few square feet.

Our product, the SurgiField system, addresses the limitations of these existing solutions by eliminating high upfront and maintenance costs, providing multi-layered protection, and offering greater freedom from external dependencies such as electricity. SurgiField also alleviates throughput bottlenecks by transforming any room into an operating room. This is done by introducing a revolutionary shift to the existing paradigm: safe surgery means protecting the surgical site, not protecting an entire room. This perspective leapfrogs big infrastructural limitations and opens up new opportunities for providing safe surgery.

With the EU's CE Mark (under MDR) regulatory approval secured, SurgiBox is now ready for global market expansion. SurgiBox Inc delivers a clean, safe solution, on the battlefield, after a disaster or crisis, at the point of injury, or anywhere you need increased surgical capacity!
